Challenge

However, rapid growth and acquisitions led to data management challenges, with scattered data across multiple databases and inconsistent definitions, impacting analysis and metrics.

- Standardized Data Definitions: Ensured consistency across metrics and KPIs, enhancing data accuracy and enabling meaningful comparisons.
- Data Lineage: Established a process for maintaining data lineage, offering a clear understanding of data history for enhanced integrity and troubleshooting during analysis.

The Outcome

Following the data governance program implementation, the healthcare provider experienced several positive outcomes:

- Automated Insights: Standardized data definitions and unified data views reduced manual manipulation time, enabling focus on extracting insights from employee-related data, enhancing decision-making in areas like hiring and retention.
- Unified Data: Disparate data sources were merged into unified tables, facilitating access to 13 months of employee data across all acquisitions and business units.
