Challenge

Assessing sustainability of alternative accommodation options for participants needing supports with daily living.

The Scheme is intending to provide alternative accommodation options to ensure the chosen level of supports provided can be altered per the participant needs and level of supports required whilst remaining cost-effective.

The Outcome

The option appears to be sustainable and could be chosen as an alternative arrangement for the participants per their level of supports required.

It is, however, in early stages and will need to be reassessed once more experience data is available.

Our Work

A new arrangement for accommodation with supports was rolled out at some select locations for the participants needing regular supports and we are now analysing the developing experience and cost-efficacy of these options to assess whether these are viable in the long term and fulfil the participant requirements as well.

The costs are analysed for various ages, disabilities and levels of severity. A comprehensive regression modelling is performed as well to evaluate the sensitivity and magnitude of various factors on the total costs.

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
